Legitimate Interest Policy

It is the policy of Aghalee Parish Church to hold, on the basis of legitimate interest, information about the names / address / telephone no / email addresses of those who claim membership of our parish congregation and/or organisations.

We have identified as a legitimate interest:

- the day to day running of Aghalee Parish Church and its' associated organisations;
- the ability to provide pastoral care to those who claim membership;
- the ability to administer our parish Free-Will Offering scheme.
- the ability to supply information about parish life and events to those who claim membership

The processing of information is necessary in order to:

- enable church leaders to provide pastoral care and support
- enable pastoral visiting
- facilitate administration of the Free-Will Offering scheme
- facilitate delivery of the parish magazine and other information
- allow the smooth running of the parish and organisations.

We have balanced this against the individual's interests, rights & freedoms

- we believe that members of Aghalee Parish would reasonably expect their details to be held and processed in this way; in order that they may be provided with pastoral care and informed about parish life.

Our commitment

- we will regularly inform our parish members that their details are held and processed in this way, through Data Privacy Notice/service-sheets / magazine / parish notice-boards / Facebook.
- we will regularly inform our parish members of their rights as an individual under GDPR
